Checkpoints Consumer Unit (CU)		
1. Is the case fill rate on Consumer Unit (CU) higher than average in the product group? (See www.dmf.no table Fyllingsgrad (Case fill rate))		
2. Is the Consumer Unit (CU) designed so that it does not cause breakage when handling and opening at the consumer?		
3. Is the packaging material in the Consumer Unit (CU) and the Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) made to minimize environmental impact?		
4. Can the packaging for Consumer Unit (CU) and Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) easily be recycled?		
5. Is the number of Consumer Units (CU) in the Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) customized with regard to food waste and sales also for small retailers?		
Checkpoints Stock Keeping Unit (SKU)		
6. Is the short side of the Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) the exposure side?		
7. Is the product labelled according to the Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) labelling requirements?		
8. Are the requirements of bar code labelling of Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) with variable measure fulfilled?		
9. Is the product labelled with Grønt Punkt Norge (Green Point Norway) and relevant pictograms?		
10. Can the combination of Consumer Unit (CU) and Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) be stacked and transported without damage to packaging and products?		
11. Is the weight of the Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) a maximum of 15 kg?		
12. Is the Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) easy to open, and with instructions showing the opening method?		
13. Can the packaging be opened without using a knife?		
14. Is the Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) designed to give the Consumer Unit (CU) a good exposure at the retailer shelf/counter?		
15. Are troughs / trays used under the products if only foil is used as Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) packaging?		
16. Is the tray with products stable when it is lifted up and inserted into the shelf after the foil has been removed?		
Checkpoints Distribution Unit (DU)		
17. Is there equal number of Stock Keeping Units (SKU) on each layer of the Distribution Unit (DU)?		
18. Is gross Distribution Unit (DU) weight less than 1000 kg?		
19. Does the product comply with the module system?		
20. Does the Distribution Unit (DU) with Stock Keeping Units (SKU) keep a stable form during transport and storage in a way that damage does not occur on the packaging?		
21. Is one of the Norwegian grocery sectors approved pallets used?
